


(EN) Biopsy punch is a standardised method for performing skin biopsies.

(EN) For wounds ≤ 4 mm gently compress or close with hydrocolloid tape. For wounds ≥ 4 mm close with sutures, clips or adhesive strips as clinically appropriate.

(EN) Gently grip and raise skin sample with small anatomical tweezers, avoiding any crushing. Separate with scissors or scalpel at base if necessary.

(EN) Hold punch between thumb and index finger. Place on upper skin surface, with moderate pressure press down in a clockwise "screwing" motion. 3.
